The project goal is to improve the socio-professional integration of youth that are at risk in undergraduate education in Prahova county.

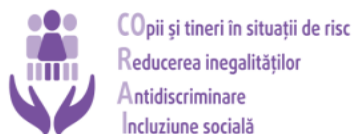
The promoter of this project is Prahova County School Inspectorate, having as **partners** Apollo Resources Center and Romers Rettigheter Association from Norway.

Beneficiaries: Young people (students and parents) were chosen according to the selection criteria concerning both personal and family situation. It is wanted project participation for young roma at risk and ensuring gender equality by applying the selection criteria.

The young people (250) are students in five schools in Prahova county: Technical College *Elie Radu*, Ploiești, Technical College Măneciu, Technical College *Toma N. Socolescu*, Ploiești, Agricol College *Gheorghe Ionescu Sisești*, Valea Călugărească, Technical College *Tase Dumitrescu*, Mizil,

Project's Aims:

- developing skills for young students in risk situations,
- improving chances for access in education and on the labour market for young students in risk situations (including student young mothers);
- preventing and reducing delinquency and social alienation due to deviant social model exposure;
- enhancing the need to awareness regarding the need for education for young students in local communities and their families, in general;
- better training for professionals involved in activities for young people and social inclusion
- enhancing access to adapted/integrated services for young students at risk.
