



The extension of the duration of the project implementation

Following the approval by the Managing Council of FRDS, the duration of the project implementation has been prolonged until the 31st of October 2016. Thus, extra activities will be done within the plus facility.

The non-formal activities develop the social and communication skills of the children, encourage creativity and free expression. These activities will be done within workshops: artistic creation, dance, music and theatre and will be mentored by personalities from the respective domains.

The interactive platform learningpark.ro is a base of interactive video lessons, which the students will use to develop scientific competencies (pertaining to mathematics, physics and chemistry) and computer skills by using the Internet.

The products made during the workshop activities will be presented in an exhibition and be sold for humanitarian purposes.

At the end of the project a “Festival for Young Talents” will be organised, which will be prepared during workshop activities.

The extra activities proposed are expected to cause change within each beneficiary of the project. Team work – students, parents and teachers – generates very good results, even if the students come from disadvantaged backgrounds.
