Aims of the remedial activities for Romanian language and literature:

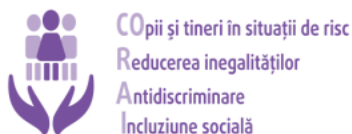
- improving school performance;
- helping students to pass their high school final exams.

Targeted skills:

- the proper use of language in producing messages;
- text comprehension and interpretation using elements of literary theory;
- the development of argumentation skills, both in writing and speaking;
- the improvement of writing techniques:
- non-fictional texts: descriptive, narrative, advertising, news, minutes, letters of intent, friendly letters, interviews;
- literary analysis essays.

Learning efficiency:

- modern methods used: role playing, the quintet, the cube, the short essay, posters, crosswords puzzles;
- modern means of learning: IT tools, audiobooks





Remedial activities for maths

Aims of the remedial activities for maths:

- improving school performance;
- helping students to pass their high school final exams.

Targeted skills sets:

- Identifying function values using their graphical representation;
- Determining equation solutions using graphical representations;
- Applying algorithms to draw the graph of II grade functions;
- Using tables and formulas for trigonometry and geometry calculations;
- Implementing practical problems into trigonometry and geometry specific language;
- Identifying graphical methods of solving equations and systems of equations or functions;
- Using combinatorial formulas to achieve inductive reasoning;
- Determining the equivalents between various ways of writing numbers;
- Applying specific algorithms for calculating complex numbers in various contexts.

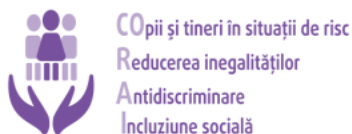
Learning efficiency:
